What a busy time it has been for all our competitive athletes and coaches during term 3, with National Club Championships, State Levels Trials, team building sessions and to finish it off with State Levels Championships over the weekend of the 30th and 31st August.

At each event, KSTP were well represented and did our club, their families and themselves proud. Many of our athletes competed for their first time, overcoming nerves to perform a newly learnt routine in front of a crowd and judges.

**The National Club Championships** were held at the Kingborough Sports Centre in Tasmania over the weekend of 1st to 3rd August. KSTP was well represented along with the other 38 clubs from around Australia. The combined results from all our athletes saw KSTP achieve it's best overall club results to date with an impressive 1st in Tumbling, 1st in Level 4 across all disciplines and 4th best club Overall!! Athlete Damon Louwen was the second highest point scorer over the weekend for Level 4, a wonderful achievement for Damon who competed in all three disciplines.

**State Levels Championships** was held at the impressive Sydney Gymnastics and Aquatic Centre in Rooty Hill over the weekend of the 30th and 31st August. Day 1 was for our Levels 1 - 3 athletes, it was so exciting to see so many fantastic routines by the end of the day we were coming first in Tumbling and sitting in first place overall as the Champion Club.

Day 2 was for our Levels 4 and above athletes, and the success didn't stop. By end of the final day of competition we were announced #1 Tumbling club, #2 Smt/Dmt club which saw us finish in an impressive 2nd place overall Champion Club.

While results are a great platform to demonstrate success, it is the sportsmanship shown from our athletes that we pride ourselves on. We believe our role as educators is not only to teach athletes to tumble and jump but to encourage and foster the values of true sportsmanship. Congratulations to all our athletes.
