Competitive Classes

Stage 1 State Squad

Stage 1 State Squad, is a first-year squad for children from our recreational classes, who show readiness for the next stage of learning.

This program focuses on tumbling, trampoline and dmt. Competition squads use the base of what has already been learned and begin to turn focus towards execution and technique. Basic skills across all disciplines will be established in order to learn the skills required to begin competing in the State Stream Levels System.

Stage 2 State Squad

Stage 2 State Squad, is a squad for athletes already accomplished in basic skills and processes. These selected children show a readiness to take their learning further to continue along the State Stream Levels System. A greater focus will be placed on strength, and flexibility which will deliver quality in the execution of their skills.

Open Intermediate Levels

Open Intermediate Levels, is based on ability for athletes of any age who wish to begin competing and become part of a team. We take the skills already practiced and begin putting them together into routines.

Greater emphasis is put on technique and execution of basic skills across all disciplines, in order to learn the routines and combinations required for the State Stream Levels System.

Open Advanced Levels

Open Advanced Levels, is a competitive squad for children who have been working well and progressing nicely through the lower levels system. Selected athletes show the right strength, form and skills to carry them forward to Levels 4 and above.

Competition squads use the base what has already been cultured and turn focus towards execution, technique and the development of higher level skills. We hope to equip these athletes with the skills and practices necessary to be successful State Stream competitors.

What is expected when your child is in a competitive program.

Being chosen for the competitive stream means your child shows potential in the areas we specialise in.

To enable athletes to learn and improve on the skills required for competition, these programs require a great deal of commitment from the athlete as well as their family.

Athletes in our competitive programs are expected to maintain a high attendance record, this includes holiday periods unless families notify the office of a planned a holiday.

Competitions

Once an athlete has the requirements for the appropriate level to compete, the athletes will be required to purchase full club uniform for competitions, including leotard, tracksuit, polo shirt. Athletes can compete from the age of 6.

KSTP hold club competitions, attend State Championships and National Clubs Carnival.

Athletes pay the Competitive Registration which is \$105 and is payable on your first paid class. Athletes who have not reached competition age will pay recreation registration, until the first competition where they will be moved over to the competitive rate.

Additional Information

A one off club registration fee of \$40 is payable on joining KSTP. Fees are payable by the invoice due date, however in consultation with our team, a payment plan can be arranged. Early bird discounts apply to competitive programs term invoices. Sibling discounts are available. Make-up classes are offered, but are required to be done within the term. There are no make-up classes Advanced, missed classes are forfeited.
