| During extreme heat | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> On days exceeding 35 degrees, KSTP will monitor the temperature in line with the forecast from the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) found at www.bom.gov.au If the temperature rises above 35 degrees but remains under 38 degrees we will hold classes with modified training and plenty of water breaks. When temperatures reach 38 degrees, a decision will be made as to classes being cancelled, this will be based on the conditions inside the gym. This decision will not be made before 1pm. Morning under 5's classes will generally run as usual. When KSTP management deem it is safer to cancel classes, members will be notified by text message and on social media. Cancelled classes will be made up at a time that fits the clubs schedule, this may be in the school holidays if classes cannot be done within the term. Refunds or credits are not provided in lieu of the make-up class. It is ultimately the responsibility of parents and care givers to monitor conditions and make the appropriate decision for their child attending or not. We encourage all parents to remove children from classes if concerned. Refunds or credits are not given if a family choose to not attend class due to the heat. |
| During floods and bridge closures | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only in the case where KSTP cancels classes will families be refunded In the case where families cannot safely get to class due to floods and bridge closures, makeup classes will be offered, and can be worked out on an individual basis. |
