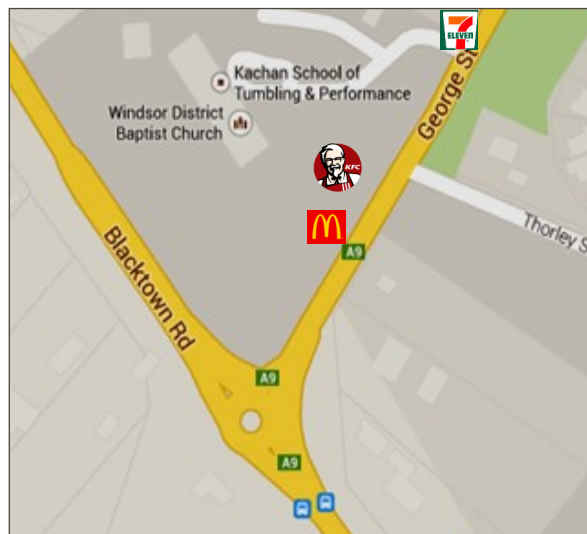

Our head coach Dima is the NSW and Australian tumbling coach, developing National tumbling and trampoline competitors who have gone on to win many titles. Internationally we began competing at the World Age Group Competition in 2013, and Senior World Championships in 2019. Amongst numerous world medals, we had an athlete become the Senior World Tumbling Champion in 2022 and again in 2025.

In 2025 we also had numerous representatives on State and National teams bringing home several medals from the Australian Gymnastics Championships, a bronze medal in the U15 World Age DMT Competition, plus Gold in the Junior World Championships for DMT and tumbling. As a club we have won the GNSW State Levels Championships and Coaching Team of the year since 2015 and in 2018, 2022 & 2023 were the recipients of Gymnastics Australia's Trampoline Sports Coaching Team of the Year.

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# Competitive Classes

## Open Intermediate Levels

Open Intermediate Levels, is a selective program for athletes from the age of 10 who wish to compete and be part of a team. We take the skills already practiced and begin putting them together into routines following the Gymnastics NSW Competition Requirements. Great emphasis is put on the technique and execution of basic skills across all disciplines, in order to learn the routines and combinations required for competition.

## Pre Advanced Levels

Pre Advanced Levels, is a competitive squad for children aged 10-12 who show excellent technique in fundamental tumbling, progressing nicely through the lower levels requirements. Selected athletes will show the right strength, form and skills to carry them forward to Level 4 and above in the Australian Levels Program. This class requires a high work ethic from all athletes, and persistence and determination to reach their potential.

## Open Advanced Levels

Open Advanced Levels, is a competitive squad for children over the age of 12 who have been working well and progressing through competition requirements. Selected athletes show the right strength, form and skills to carry them forward to Levels 4 and above in the Australian Levels Program. Athletes require persistence courage and hard work, skills they can apply in all aspects of their lives.



## What is expected when your child is in a competitive program.

Being chosen for the competitive stream means your child shows potential in the areas we specialize in.

To enable athletes to learn and improve on the skills required for competition, these programs require a great deal of dedication and commitment from the athlete as well as their family.

Athletes in our competitive programs are expected to maintain a high attendance record, including the school holidays.

## Competitions

Once an athlete has the requirements for the appropriate level to compete, the athletes will be required to purchase full club uniform for competitions, including leotard, tracksuit, polo shirt.

KSTP hold club competitions, attends State Championships and the National Clubs Carnival. Level 4 routines are required for athletes selected to compete at the National Clubs Carnival

## Gymnastics NSW Annual Registration/Affiliation

KSTP is proudly an affiliated member of Gymnastics NSW as such each member at KSTP must become an affiliated member and required to pay the annual affiliation/insurance fee.

Athletes pay the Competitive Registration which is \$130 and is payable on your first paid class.

## Additional Information

A one off club registration fee of \$55 is payable on joining KSTP. Fees are payable by the invoice due date, however in consultation with our team, a payment plan can be arranged. Early bird discounts apply to competitive programs term invoices. Sibling discounts are available.

Make-up classes are offered in all programs where there is an extra day within the week for training.
